

## Adverse Childhood Experience (ACE)

**70% of adults** in the U.S. have experienced some type of traumatic event at least once in their lives. That's 223.4 million people!

## What is an ACE Score & Why Does it Matter?

**The Adverse Childhood Experience** questionnaire is based off an original study by the CDC and Kaiser Permanente with 17,000 subjects published in 1998. After two decade of continued research this assessment is still the primary tool in understanding the impact of early childhood trauma.

## The Staggering Effects of Unhealed TRAUMA

Men with six or more ACEs were 46 times more likely to have injected drugs than men with no history of adverse childhood experiences

20 percent of these people go on to develop posttraumatic stress disorder, or PTSD. Approximately 5 million children are exposed to domestic violence every year. Children exposed are more likely to attempt suicide, abuse drugs and alcohol, run away from home, engage in teenage prostitution, and commit sexual assault crimes.





90 percent of clients in public behavioral health care settings have experienced trauma.
